



# INSTALLATION GUIDE





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#### Clean and Dry the Surface:

- 1. Ensure the car and installation area are at least 50°F (10°C) to guarantee proper Wear Bar adhesion
- 2. **Wash Thoroughly:** Use a car wash solution or a mix of Dawn detergent to remove grease and dirt. For heavily soiled areas, wash twice for optimal results.
- 3. **Focus on Details:** Pay special attention to tight spaces, such as the area between the under-bumper fascia and the valance panel, ensuring all debris is removed.
- 4. **Dry Completely:** Make sure the surface is fully dry, with no water remaining, before moving on to the next step.



#### **Placement Marker Tips:**

**Use a Guide Wear Bar: Leave the backer tape on** one Wear Bar to use as a **GUIDE WEAR BAR** for determining the seven final mounting positions.

**Mark Positions:** Work one position at a time. Use the **GUIDE WEAR BAR** to identify the optimal placement and mark the end of the Wear Bar with a **Placement Marker**.

**Ensure Precision:** Placement Markers are essential for precise alignment and accurate positioning of the Wear Bars during final installation.

### Attaching the Placement Markers:

- Prepare the Guide Wear Bar: Remove one Wear Bar from the kit, leaving the tape backer on. This will serve as the GUIDE WEAR BAR.
- Identify Locations: Slide the GUIDE WEAR BAR along the surface to find the desired mounting positions.
- Attach Placement Markers:
   Align each Placement
   Marker parallel to the end of the GUIDE WEAR BAR and attach it to the car.
- Ensure Flat Contact: Make sure the GUIDE WEAR BAR sits completely flat. Adjust positions as needed for accuracy.
- Repeat: Continue this process for all remaining positions.









#### **Alcohol Pad Pre-Cleaning:**

- 1. **Prepare the Alcohol Pad:** Remove an alcohol prep pad from the kit, tear open the packaging, and take out the pad.
- Clean the Mounting Areas: For each Placement Marker position, use the alcohol pad to thoroughly clean the immediate areas where the Wear Bars will be mounted.



#### Using the 3M94 Primer Stick:

- 1. **Ventilation:** Ensure the area is well-ventilated to minimize exposure to primer fumes.
- 2. **Activate the Primer Stick:** Press firmly on the black dot to crack the internal seal, allowing the primer to flow to the brush.
- Apply the Primer: For each Placement Marker position, use the brush to apply primer to the immediate areas where the Wear Bars will be mounted.
- Maintain Fluid Flow: If the brush begins to lose fluid, hold it with the bristles pointing downward for a few moments to allow the primer to refill the brush.

5) Attach Wear Bars



Wear Bar Attachment Tips:

## ENSURE THE CAR AND INSTALLATION AREA are at least 50°F (10°C) to guarantee proper Wear Bar adhesion.

**Work One at a Time:** Remove the tape backers one Wear Bar at a time, as the adhesive is extremely sticky. Attach each Wear Bar before moving to the next.

**Remove Backers from Corner:** Peel the tape backers from one corner using a pin or pointy tool as shown. Piercing the tape slightly will not cause damage.

**Align Front Edge First:** Allow only the front edge of the Wear Bar to contact the surface, ensuring it is perfectly aligned with the Placement Tape. If misaligned, lift it off and realign.

**Secure the Wear Bar:** Once aligned, press the Wear Bar firmly against the car and hold for 60 seconds to ensure proper adhesion. Full adhesive strength occurs in 24 hours.

#### Attaching the Wear Bars:

- Remove Tape Backers: Peel the tape backer from the first Wear Bar, starting at one corner.
- Align and Attach: Align the Wear Bar with the end of the Placement Tape and POSITION THE FRONT EDGE FIRST as shown.
- Apply: Press the Wear Bar firmly onto the car and hold for one minute to ensure adhesion.
- Repeat: Repeat for all remaining Wear Bar positions.
- Remove Placement Tape:
   Once all Wear Bars are attached, remove the Placement Tape.
- 6. Installation Complete!
